2. Develop Capacity
The degree to which the project builds capacity within the region, for improved regional development in the future. Specifically, in the areas of workforce development, education, redevelopment a entrepreneurship.
Capacity points (0-20)
3. Employment Numbers
Number of full time jobs and/or full time equivalents created or retained by project.
Jobs Created /Retained (0-20)
4. Employment - Wages
The degree to which the wages associated with jobs that are created or retained are equal to, below
above the average wage for that industry in Windham County. Add an additional 10 points if the jo
are above the current average annual wage in Windham County. (Windham County annual wa \$38,998 Source: Bureau of Economic Analysis)
Applications will be scored on a 0-20 scale. With 10 point additional bonus with wages above the curre
annual wage.

5. Leverages External Assets

The degree to which the project leverages external (investments coming into Windham Region from outside of the area) human, social, financial, cultural, or physical capital, for benefit within the Windham Region.
