What is Conserved Land?

Land that is permanently protected from development and unsustainable resource extraction

Open to the public for a variety of defined uses (with the exception of some privately conserved lands)

Depending on the easement and management plan, may be managed for wildlife benefits, old growth characteristics, carbon, sustainable timber harvest, maple sugar, and other environmental, community and economic goals


