Things to Know

Bicycles:

- Wear a helmet that fits properly
- Use lights or reflectors so cars can see you
- Ride your bike in the same direction as the cars are driving
- Buses have 2 bike racks

More training on bicycles and how to get one will be available in the spring



Moover Medicaid Bus:

- Provides door-to-door service to medical appointments
- Must be arranged in advance
- Bus will say DEMAND RESPONSE

safely in the US?**

Walking Safety

- Use the sidewalk if available
- Be visible in the dark
 - Use a flashlight
 - Wear light or reflective clothing
- Wear proper footwear especially in winter
- Wear clothing that works for the weather conditions

When there is no sidewalk:

- Walk on the left side of the road
- Make sure you are facing oncoming traffic
- Stay aware of cars coming towards you



Public Transportation: The Moover Microtransit

- Called MicroMoo
- Reservations are required! - Van will not stop if you are not on their list
- On demand transportation service within Brattleboro Town Limits
- Hours are Monday - Friday 5:00-11:30pm
- Works like Uber only it's free

- #4 Red Line: Monday - Saturday
- #5 Blue Line: Weekdays Only
